Fig. 1: Estimated population distribution of Sutton, 2014 and 2024

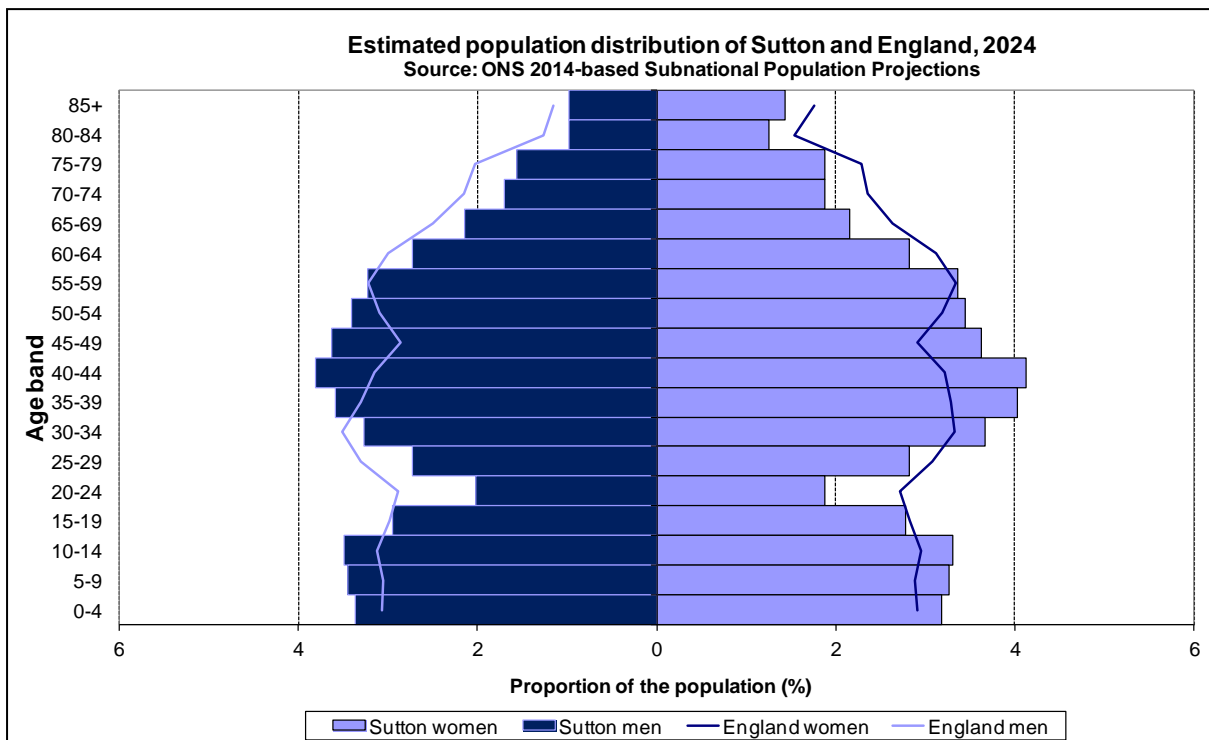
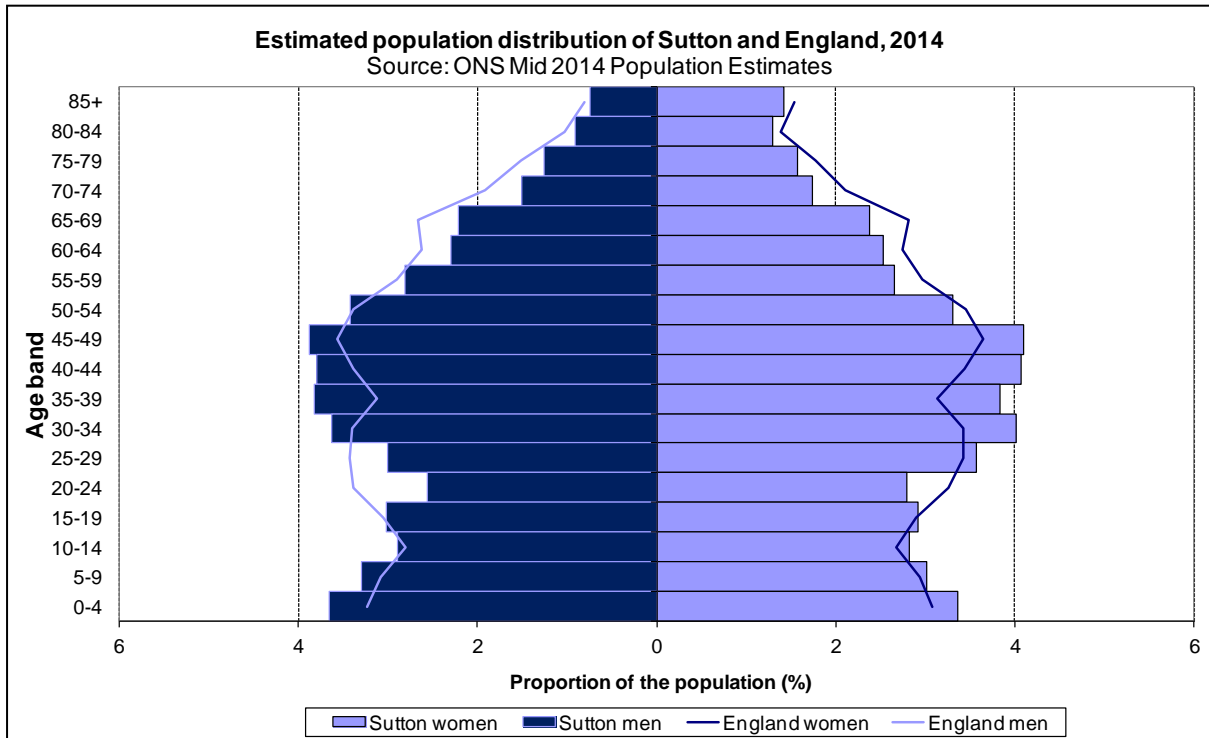


Fig. 2: Comparing population growth from 2014 to 2024 by age band

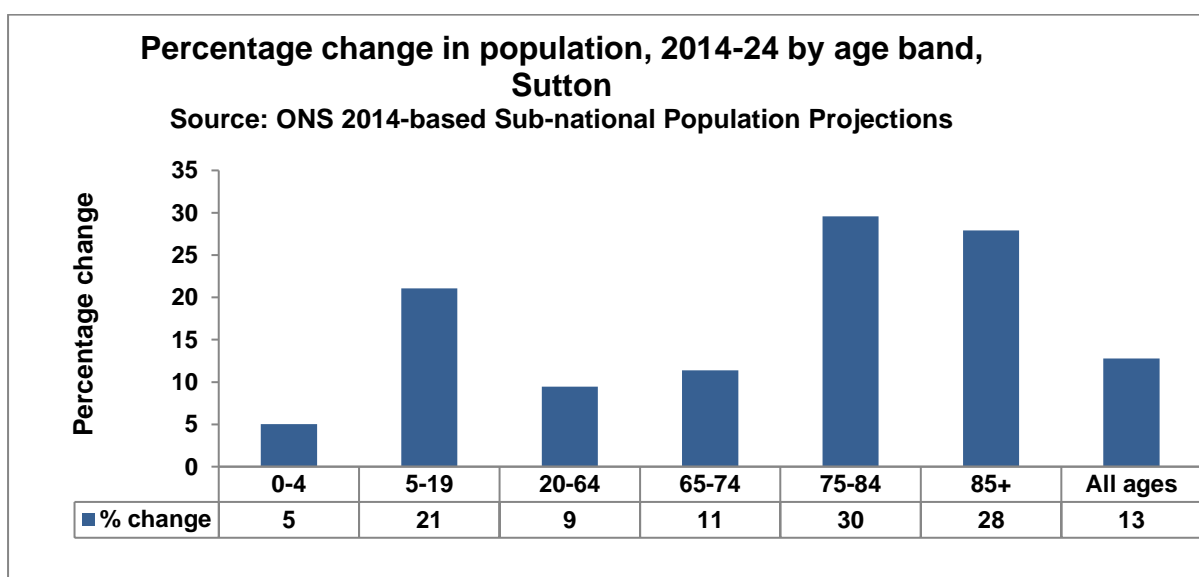
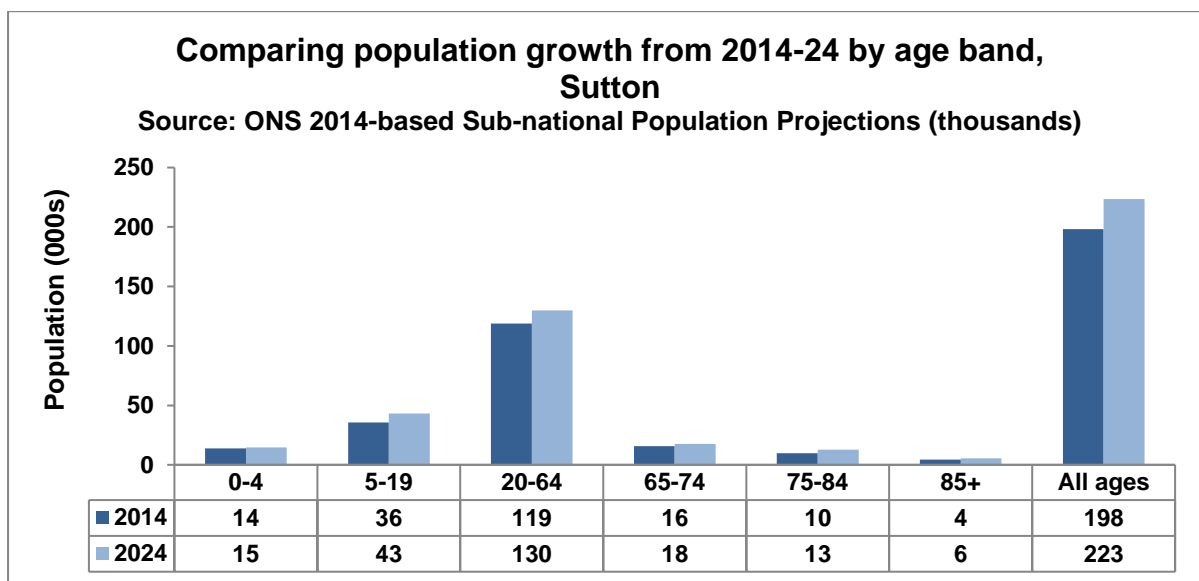




Fig. 3: Population Projections, all ages, and by age group

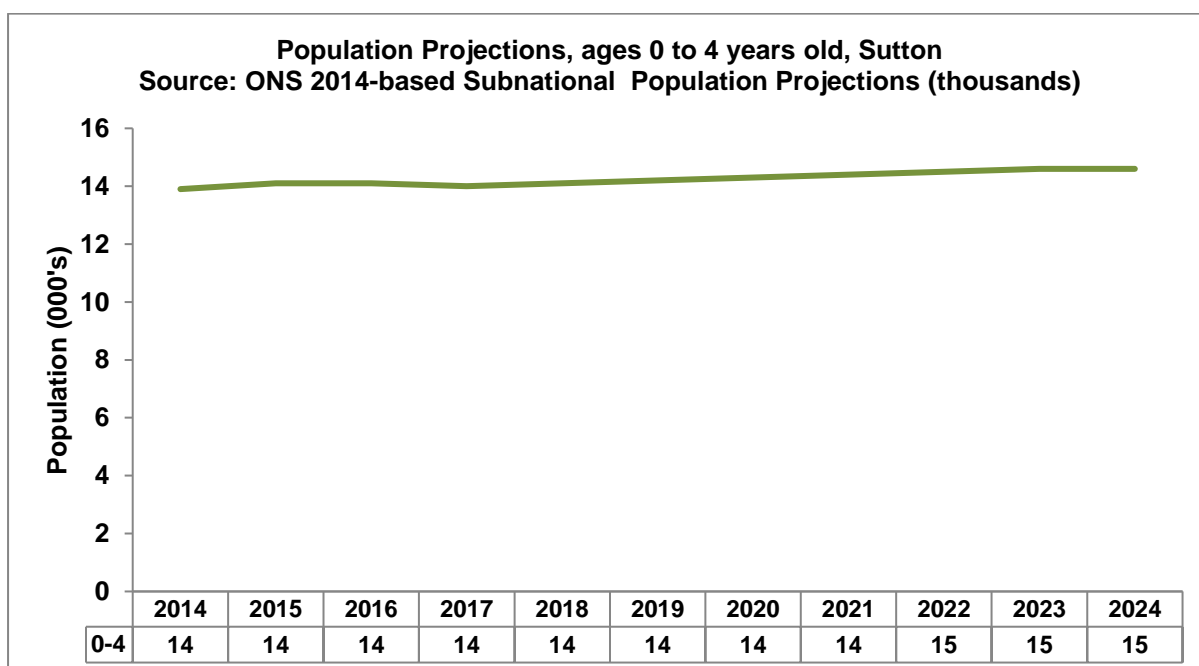
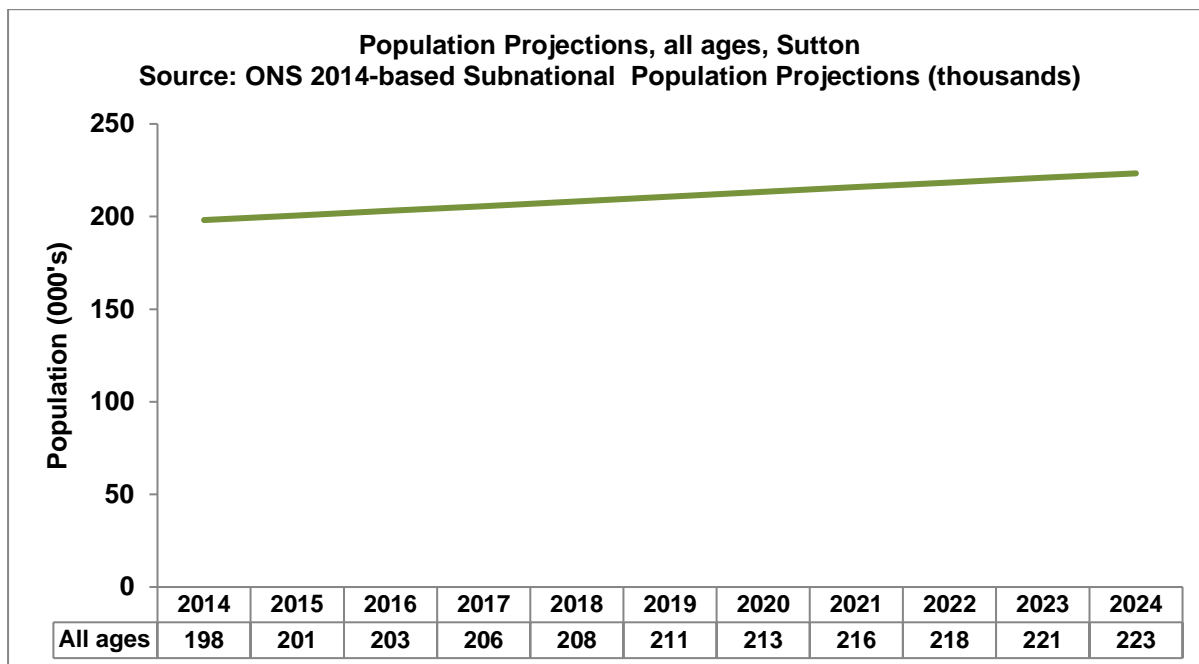

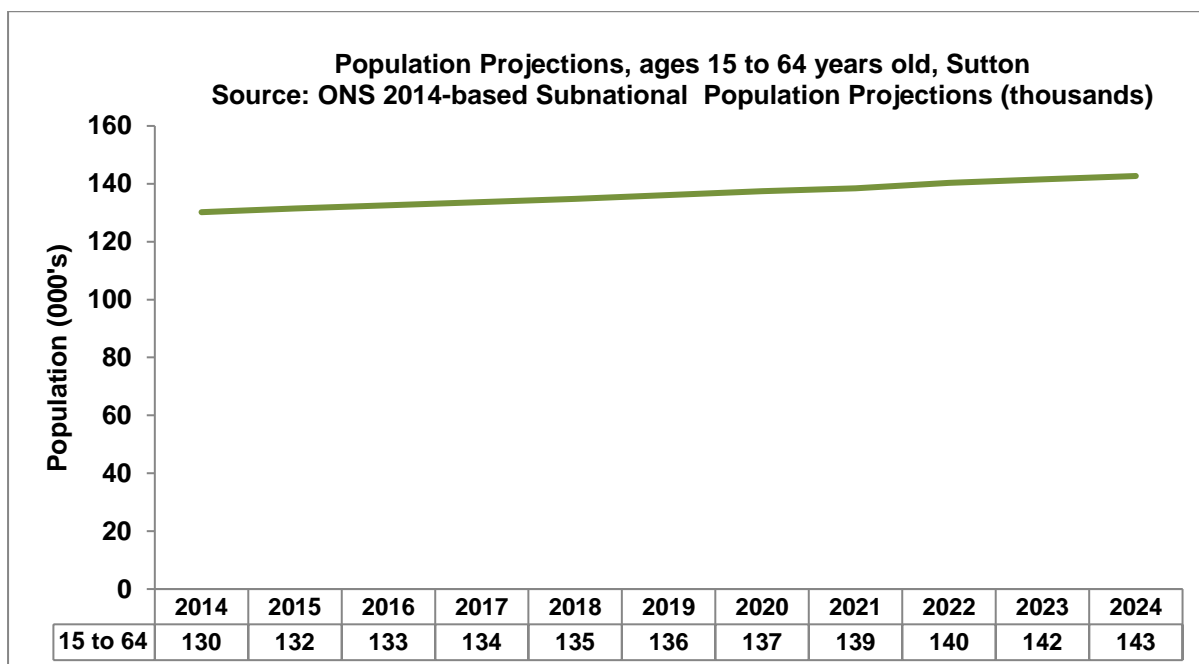
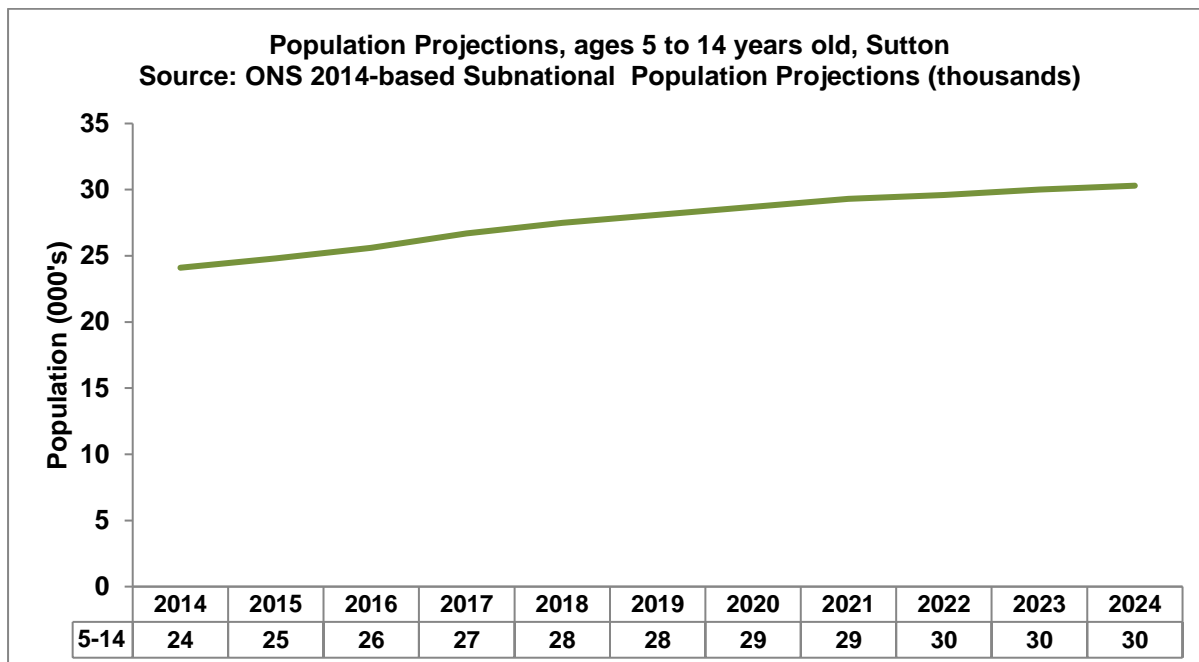

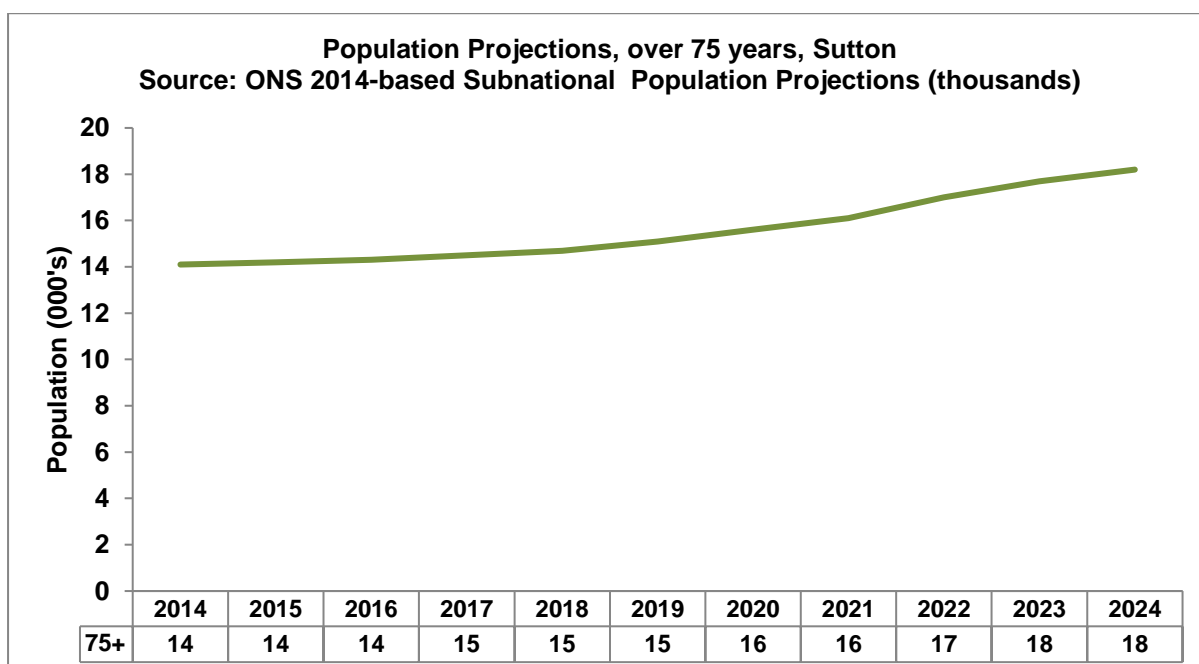
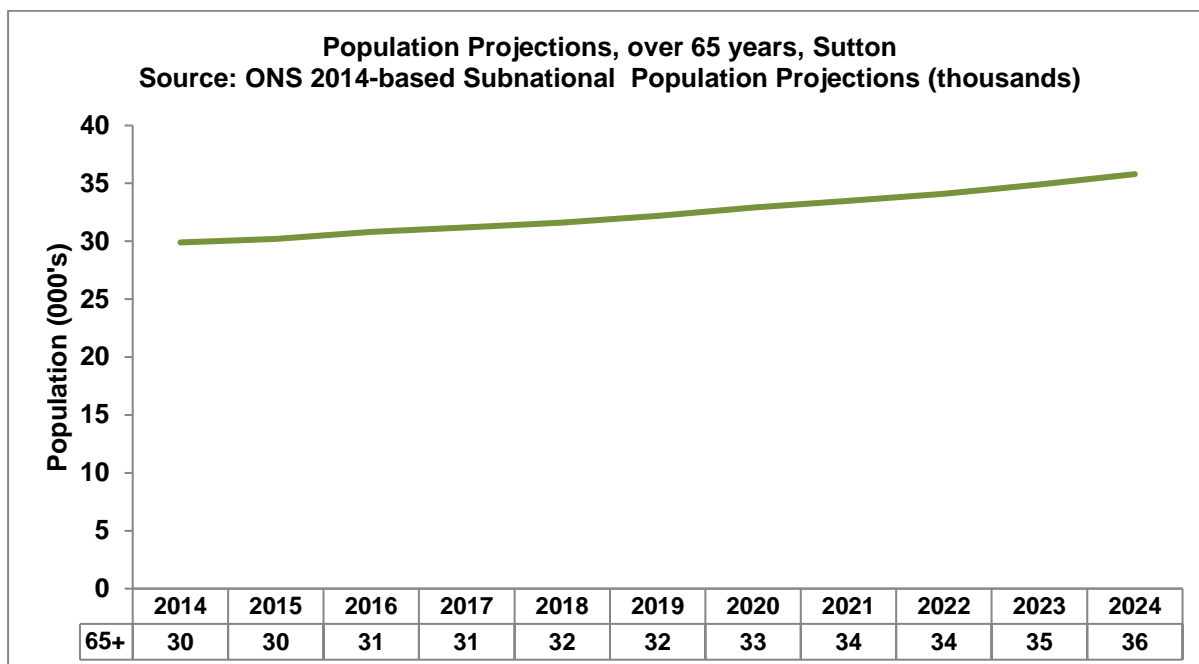


Fig 4: Registered Population in Sutton, January 2017

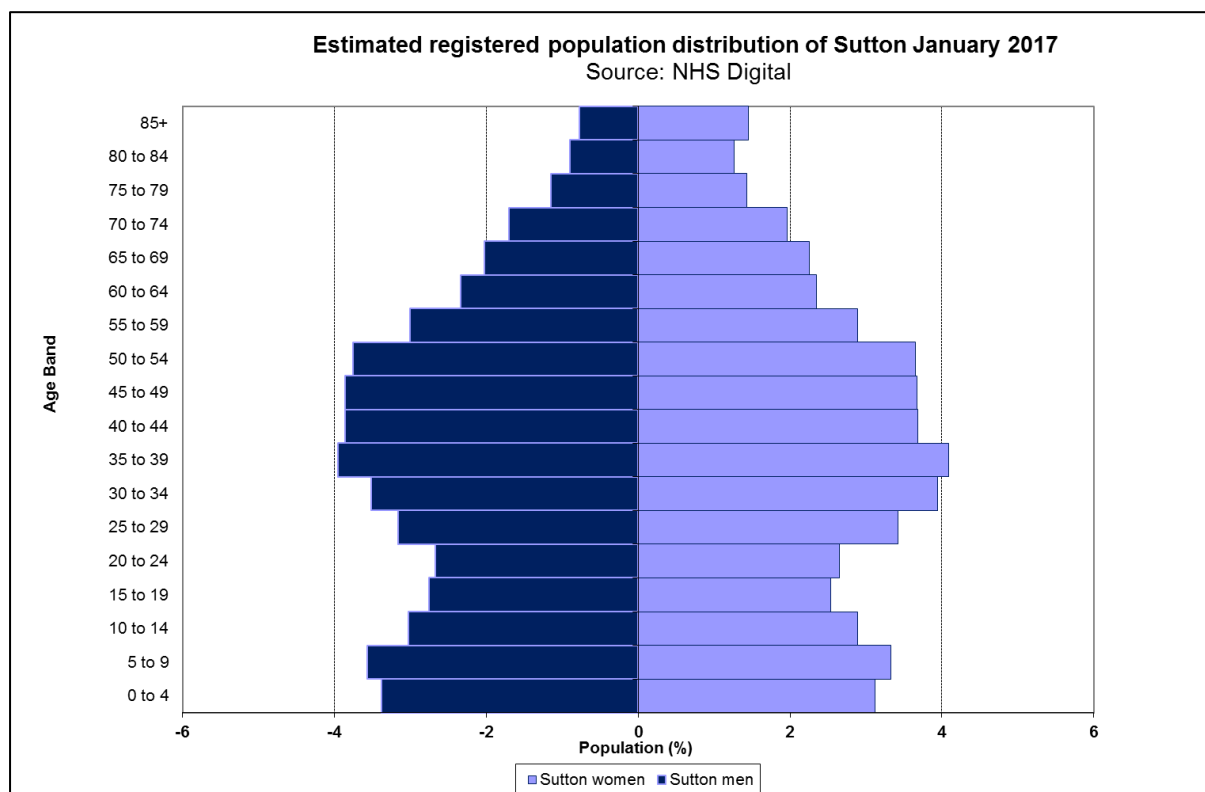


Fig. 5: Population of Sutton by electoral ward and by age group

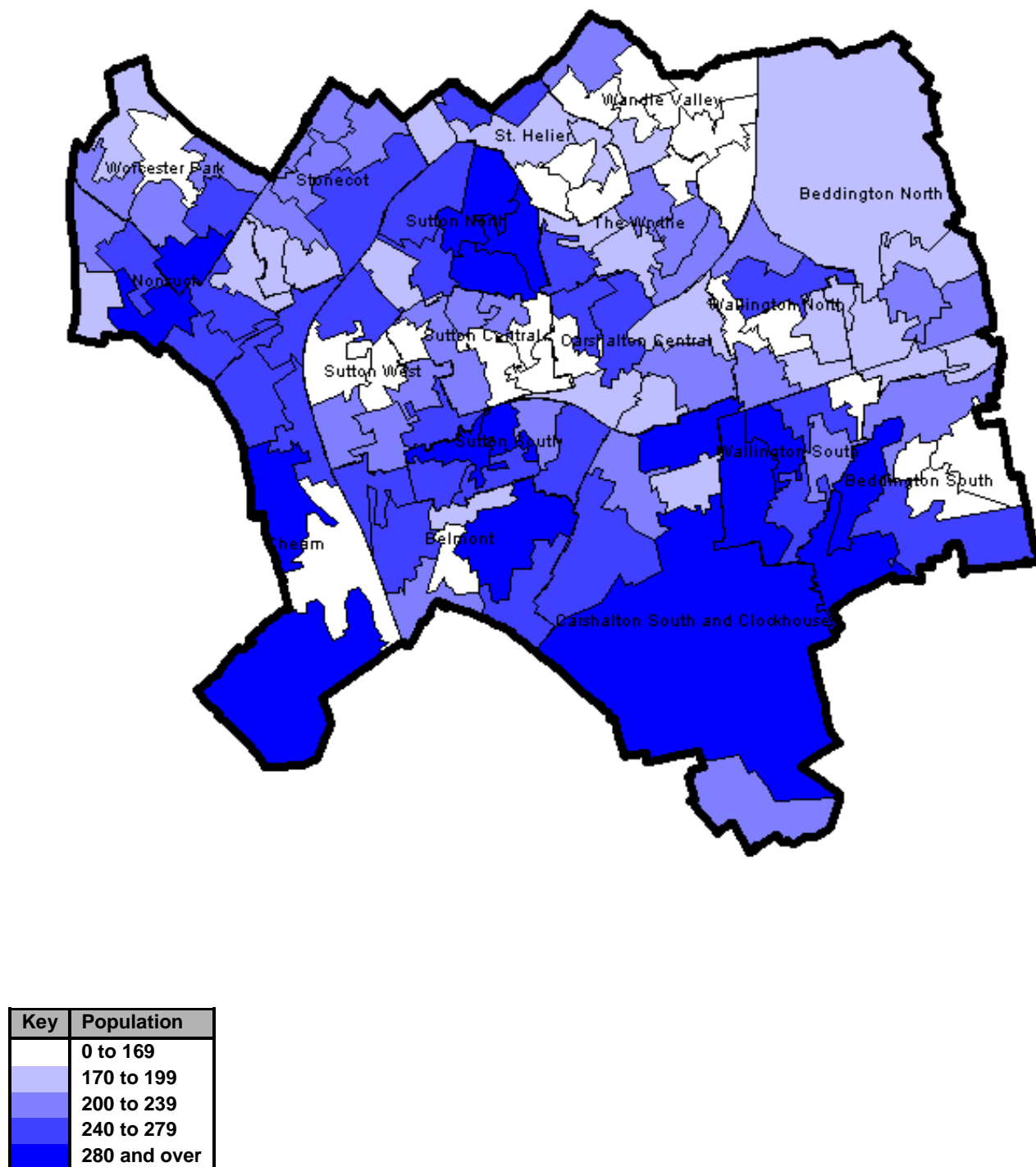

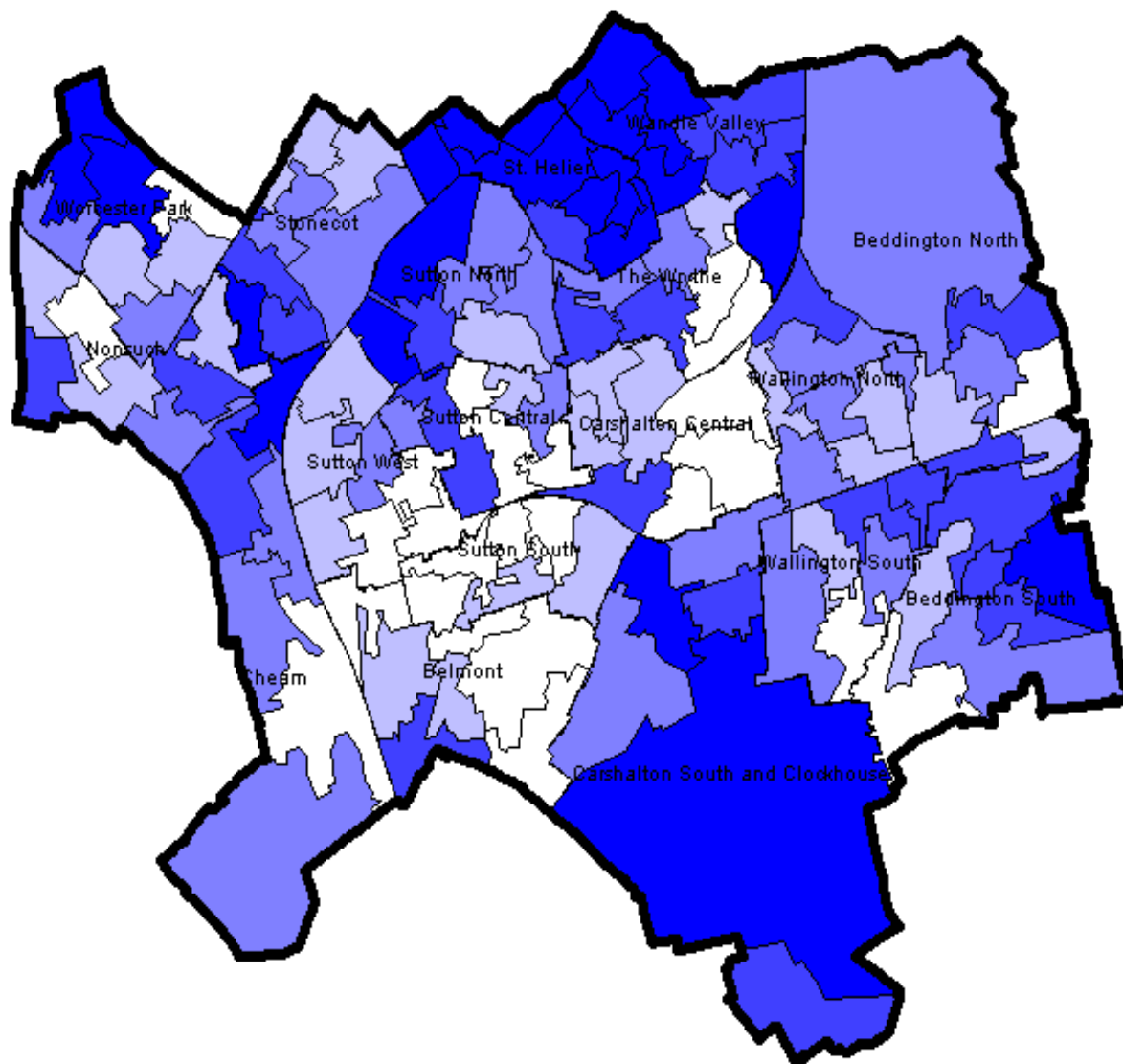
